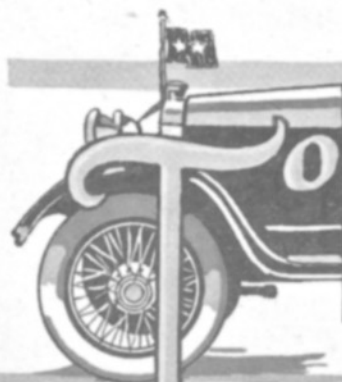

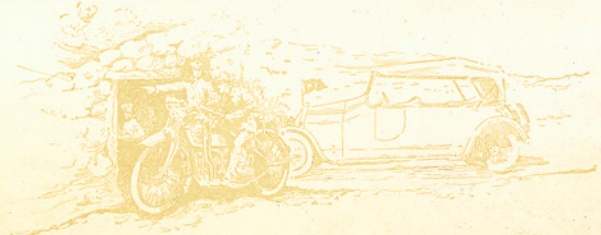

FOREWORD

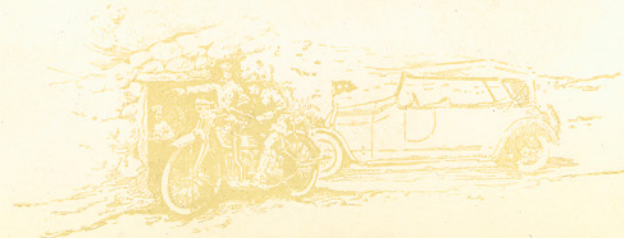

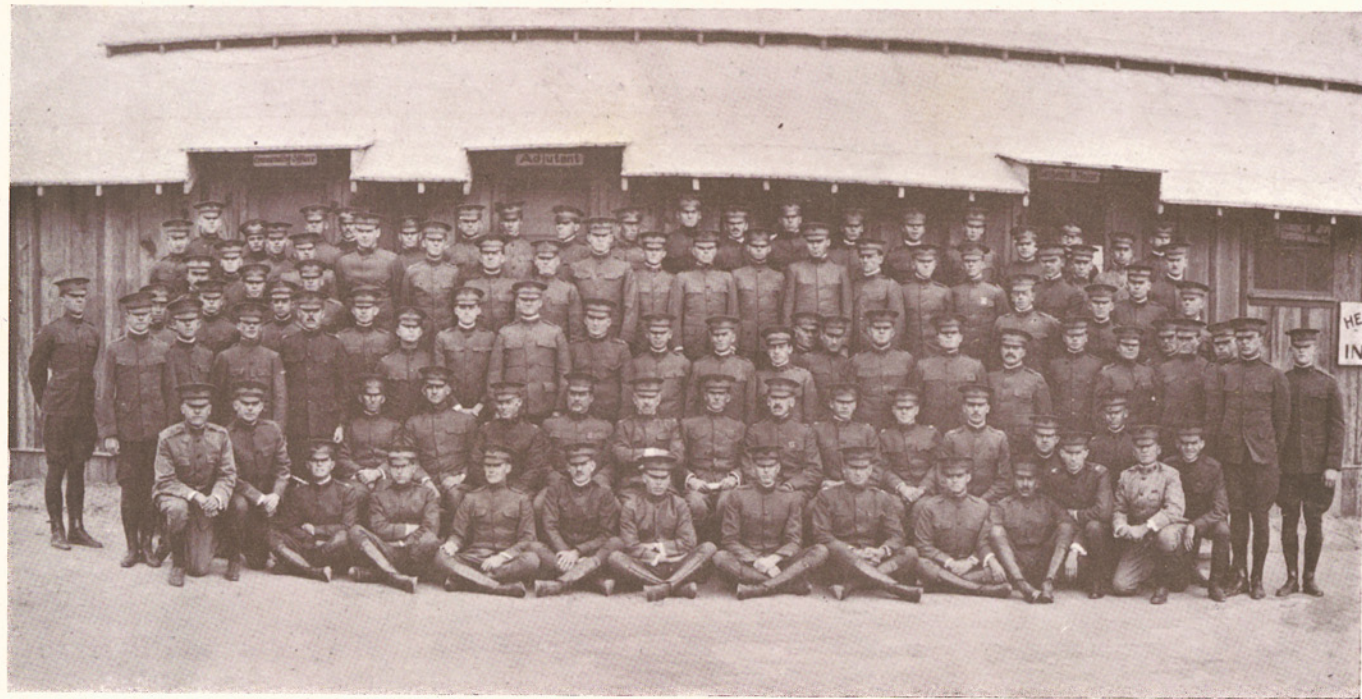


View of Camp
Section occupied by 319th and 320th Regiments

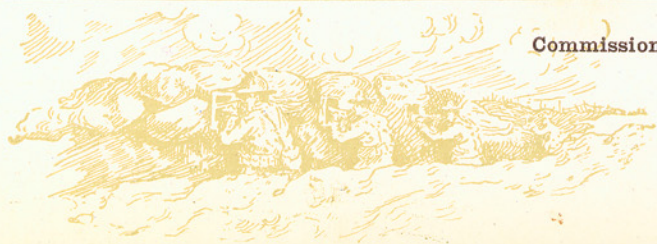

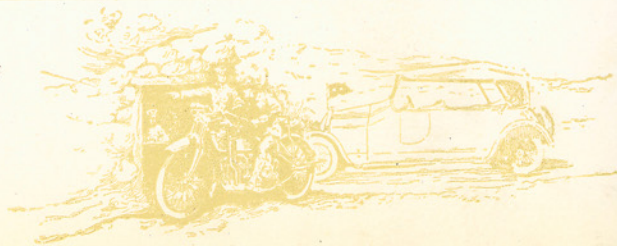


View of Camp
